

# General Rules of Technical Conferences

## 1. Objective

In order to effectively achieve the targets set by the Nuclear Risk Research Center (henceforth the "NRRC"), which plays a core role in the R&D that is necessary to voluntary safety improvements, all institutions involved will cooperate to: develop the NRRC's organization, activity policy and plans; incorporate R&D output into concrete measures, hence inform such outcomes to the public.

## 2. Composition

- (1) The committee shall be composed of executives managing the relevant operations at the concerned divisions of the NRRC, the nine utilities, The Japan Atomic Power Company, Japan Nuclear Fuel Limited, Electric Power Development Co., Ltd., Toshiba Energy Systems & Solutions Corporation, Hitachi-GE Nuclear Energy, Ltd., Mitsubishi Heavy Industries, Ltd., the Federation of Electric Power Companies of Japan, the Japan Electrical Manufacturers' Association and the Japan Nuclear Safety Institute.
- (2) An executive from the NRRC shall serve as the Technical Conference's Chair.
- (3) Observer participation may be accepted at the Chair's discretion.
- (4) The Chair may, if he/she deems it necessary, invite NRRC executives and external experts in addition to committee members, and request opinions and reports from NRRC.

## 3. Meetings

Meetings may be held as required at the Chair's discretion.

## 4. Scope of deliberation

- (1) The NRRC's activity policy and activity plan
- (2) Matters relating to the NRRC's organization
- (3) R&D roadmaps and research plan
- (4) Evaluation and publication of R&D results
- (5) Other matters related to the NRRC's activities

## 5. Secretariat

The Technical Conference shall be run by the NRRC's Planning & Administrative Team.

## 6. Supplement

Any matters not stipulated in general rules shall be determined on a case-by-case basis.
